4goodfruit has been developed to be a fund raising agency for **Amos Agrimin** by using the surplus capacity principle.

With this principle, funds (donations, loans, grants, etc) are invested and multiplied through different farming enterprises. The return on these investments is very high ($\pm 50\%$ per annum) and is allocated to **Amos Agrimin** to support the ministry. **4goodfruit** has invested more than R480 000 in contracts for the production of sheep, cattle (milk and meat), maize and pigs. However, in order to effectively support the ministry, a minimum start-up capital of R2.5 million is required to be multiplied by **Amos** farmers.

God's word teaches us that we don't get what we need, because we don't ask for it. Therefore we ask all Amossies to unite in prayer and ask God's favor to give **4goodfruit** the necessary funds to be multiplied through the principle of spare capacity.
